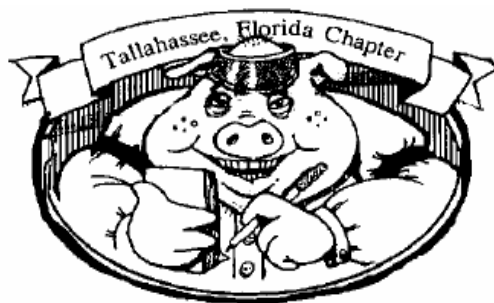

### 2008 In Review

What a year, was it great or what.....? This will be my last letter for this year. Don't worry I'll be back to hound everyone next year to keep you on top of your game, SAFETY WISE. Let's make next year better, just think safety before and during each ride. I have put together my top ten safety hints for this year. Have you been listening?

1. Check you tire pressure **every week**.
2. Upgrade as many of your lighting packages on your ride. **Try To BE SEEN!**
3. The best item I put on my ride this year is..... (Drum roll Please).....An Air **Horn!!!!** Think about it, most of your riding is in the day time and you hope your lights can be seen! **BARK A LOUD HORN** and you can see the difference with other driver's responses.
4. Get your eyes checked....**Up Grade YOUR GLASSES!!!!** Put your new lens into some riding gear and make sure you get day & night pair.
5. You must be prepared to ride in all seasonal conditions, have the correct gear and use it often!!!!
6. Practice emergency stopping at least once a month. **THINK ABOUT IT!!!!**
7. **Learn to ride in groups!!** Not only is it fun but safety in numbers, See you on our next ride,
8. **WELL, If you don't know?** Ask! Most of the long time riders want to pass on life's tips on good riding practices
9. Never, never let your guard down when you jump on your beast when you go out for a jaunt. Believe it, the road ways are for ever changing.
10. Keep your head up and always look for a way out.....of trouble .....If need be.

**Recently HOG has asked that we update our activities calendar to comply with HOG requirements. Chapter activities are conducted primarily for the benefit of H.O.G. chapter members; however guests are welcome at closed and open events. There are three categories of activities; all activities are identified as follows: Closed events are those chapter events which are open to chapter members and one guest per member. (Most HOG rides are closed, however guests may participate. Closed events will continue to be a HOG sanctioned event as long as 51% of the participants are HOG members.) Member events are events that are open only to H.O.G. members. Open events are those chapter events which are open to chapter members, national H.O.G. members and other guests as desired. The listing of events below, are labeled using these new guidelines.**

#### **Nov 6-11: Vietnam Traveling Memorial Wall**

The Vietnam Traveling Memorial Wall will be on display in the city park on the south shore of Lake Ella from November 6th through November 11th, Veteran's Day. The Opening Ceremony will begin on November 7th. The Wall is a 3/5 scale of the Vietnam Memorial in Washington, DC. It stands six feet tall at the center and covers almost 300 feet from end to end. This Traveling Memorial stands as a reminder of the great sacrifices made during the Vietnam War. It was made for the purpose of helping heal and rekindle friendships and to allow people the opportunity to visit loved ones in their home town who otherwise may not be able to make the trip to Washington.

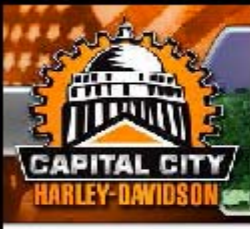
